

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar year 2017

The City of Ingleside, Texas purchases natural gas from CenterPoint Energy. At this time for the Calendar Year 2017, the City consumption usage is unavailable due to Hurricane Harvey.

The City purchases electricity from GEXA Energy. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 2,783,380 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from San Patricio County Municipal Water District. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 340,947,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the Calendar Year 2017 is \$1,413,494.36.
