**COVID-19 UPDATE – MARCH 22, 2020**

As of NOON today, there have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, San Patricio County or Aransas County. Nueces County has still only one confirmed case, which we told you about yesterday.

We ask that you remain vigilant and report anything you see which may be cause for concern. Call your neighbors and check on them. We are all in this together—and we will get through this together!

What can you do:

- The next two weeks are critical in slowing the spread of COVID-19.
- Stay home as much as possible especially if you are sick, older and/or have a medical condition.
- If you are sick, stay home except to access medical care. If you are able to take care of yourself, stay home, if you need to see your doctor, call ahead.
- Avoid gatherings of 10 or more people and non-essential trips into the public.
- Limit close contact with other people.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
