COVID-19 UPDATE – MARCH 25, 2020

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 4 PM today.

San Patricio County announced today there has been a second positive test in our County for COVID-19. This case is the result of close contact by a San Patricio County resident with an existing positive COVID-19 individual.

The San Patricio Department of Health has set up a call center from 8 AM to 5 PM Monday through Friday. The number to call is 361-201-0551.

The Texas Department of State Health Services is directing persons to call 211 for advice on services in their area.

Today we were informed immediately by one of our Industrial partners of a person who went to the doctor with symptoms related to COVID-19. The person was tested for the virus and is now quarantined, awaiting test results. The area where the worker performed his duties was immediately shut down, all workers sent home, and deep cleaning and disinfecting protocols implemented. We would like to commend them on their prompt notification, and prompt response to stop the potential spread of this virus.
