**COVID-19 UPDATE – MARCH 26, 2020**

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 4 PM today. There have been no new confirmed cases in San Patricio County for COVID-19, so the total remains at 2. The number of confirmed cases in Nueces County is 18. Nueces County has issued a Stay at Home order which takes effect at 11:59 PM tonight and will continue until April 8, 2020.

The case we told you about yesterday from one of our Industrial partners, has been returned as negative for COVID-19. We would like to again thank them for the prompt notification of the negative results.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and in the interest of public health, our City Council voted to postpone our City Elections to November 3, 2020. Council also voted to extend the Mayor's Declaration of Disaster.

As of today, our City Offices are still closed to the public, but our employees are ready and willing to assist you by phone. Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS personnel are always on duty and always ready to assist you. The City of Ingleside does NOT have a curfew in place right now.

I encourage all of you to register, or update your profile, on the Coastal Bend Coordination & Alert Network (CBCAN). It takes only a couple minutes of your time, but will allow you to receive important updates, and emergency notification, if necessary, from the City of Ingleside.
