**COVID-19 UPDATE – MARCH 30, 2020**

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. We now have 2 confirmed cases in Aransas County, 2 confirmed cases in San Patricio County, Kleberg County has 1 case, Jim Wells County has 1 case, and Nueces County now has 31 confirmed cases.

The numbers that this pandemic is producing daily is shocking. As of this evening, the State of Texas shows to have 3202 confirmed cases—that's up 376 since YESTERDAY, and an **increase of 1193 since Friday**. There have also been 46 deaths due to this virus in Texas—up 9 since yesterday.

Today is the first day of the Ingleside Stay at Home Order. As a reminder, all residents are required to stay at home, except when securing healthcare, purchasing food and basic supplies, exercising outdoors, or working as an essential employee to provide basic services to the public. While performing these activities you must always practice social distancing—as this is the best way to stop the spread of COVID-19.

As part of the Stay at Home Order, a curfew is in effect from 11PM to 5AM every night. This prohibits persons from loitering, idling, or congregating in or around any public streets, highway, alley or park during those hours unless performing a function related to as exempted business.

In my continued promise for transparency, I want to advise you of a person recently working in Ingleside that displayed symptoms related to COVID-19. They were tested for COVID-19 and the result was positive. They were quarantined, and the business where they worked has gone above and beyond to ensure the workplace was thoroughly disinfected. This business is now closed, as they are not considered an essential business, as outlined in the Stay at Home Order. I remain in contact with the business owner, will continue to monitor this situation, and will provide any updates as they become available.

Our City Offices will remain closed to the public; however, our employees are ready and willing to assist you by phone. Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS personnel are always on duty and always ready to assist you.
