COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 2, 2020

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. We do, however, have one City of Ingleside employee that has displayed symptoms, is being tested, and has been quarantined. Their workplace has been disinfected, and all employees continue to practice good social distancing.

The number of confirmed cases continues to rise in Texas, as well as in other parts of the nation. Texas is now reporting 4,669 cases (increase of 672 in one day) with 70 fatalities (increase of 12 in one day) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 50,679 tests given across Texas. Earlier today, San Patricio County reported its third confirmed case of COVID-19.

Across the United States there have been 243,229 confirmed cases (increase of 28,785 in one day), with 5,794 deaths (increase of 1000 in one day).

The above numbers are shocking—which is why all residents are required to stay at home, **except when securing healthcare, purchasing food and basic supplies, exercising outdoors, or working as an essential employee to provide basic services to the public.** While performing these activities you must always practice social distancing—as this is the best way to stop the spread of COVID-19.

The City of Ingleside still has a curfew in effect from 11PM to 5AM every night. This prohibits persons from loitering, idling, or congregating in or around any public streets, highway, alley or park during those hours unless performing a function related to an exempted business.

Ingleside City services continue to be available on a limited scale through phone and e-mail. Law Enforcement, Fire, and EMS personnel are always on duty and always ready to assist you.
