COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 20, 2020

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County has reported one additional case today, bringing their total to 12 with 97 tests administered (no new tests administered today). Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-1, Live Oak County-4, Kleberg County-6, Jim Hogg-1, Brooks County-1, Bee County-5, and Nueces County-90.

Texas is now reporting 19,458 cases (increase of 2,087 since Friday) with 495 fatalities (increase of 67 since Friday) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 190,394 tests given across Texas (20,858 since Friday). On a positive note—there have been an estimated 5,706 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol (1,516 since yesterday).

Governor Greg Abbott announced earlier today that the Texas National Guard will be mobilizing more than 1200 members to assist 25 COVID-19 mobile testing teams. These teams will be deployed based on assessments made by the Texas Department of State Health Services. These 1200 members will join the more than 2,500 already deployed and serving in various capacities in response to this activation.

The City of Ingleside remains under a Stay-at-Home Order with all previous restrictions still in place. The City is carefully evaluating and preparing a strategic plan to re-open our city, while continuing to abide by safe standards to ensure our residents remain healthy. We will continue to enforce restrictions that are in place to mitigate the spread of this virus. Please continue to practice good hygiene, social distance, and cover your nose and mouth when in public places.

Thank you all for your continued cooperation in stopping the spread of this virus.
