COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 21, 2020

There have been no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County is still reporting 12 total cases after administering 102 tests. Four of those persons have recovered, leaving 8 active cases in San Patricio County. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-1, Live Oak County-4, Kleberg County-7, Jim Hogg-1, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, Bee County-5, and Nueces County-90. There has been one death reported in Nueces County and one death in Kleberg County.

Texas is now reporting 20,196 cases (increase of 738 since yesterday) with 517 fatalities (increase of 22 since yesterday) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 205,399 tests given across Texas (15,005 since yesterday). On a positive note—there have been an estimated 6,486 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol (780 since yesterday).

Today, I signed Amendment #6 to my Mayoral Declaration of Disaster and Order. This newest Amendment will allow for retail services that are not “essential services” to re-open effective 12:01 AM on Friday, April 24, 2020 provided they are able to provide their service through pick-up, delivery by mail, or delivery to the customer’s doorstep.

This Amendment will also re-open LIVE OAK PARK only, effective at 8 AM on Thursday, April 23, 2020. All playground equipment and toy structures within the park will remain excluded from public use.

The City of Ingleside Stay-at-Home Order with all previous restrictions is still in effect. The City is carefully evaluating and preparing a strategic plan to re-open our city, while continuing to abide by safe standards to ensure our residents remain healthy. We will continue to enforce restrictions that are in place to mitigate the spread of this virus. Please continue to practice good hygiene, social distance, and cover your nose and mouth when in public places.
