COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 22, 2020

There are still no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County is back at 11 total cases after administering 101 tests. Yesterday, they were reporting 12 cases, but one of their cases turned out to be an out of county case. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-1, Live Oak County-4, Kleberg County-7, Jim Hogg-1, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, Bee County-5, and Nueces County-90. Nueces County is reporting no new cases for the fourth day in a row.

Texas is now reporting 21,069 cases (increase of 873 since yesterday) with 543 fatalities (increase of 26 since yesterday) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 216,783 tests given across Texas (11,384 since yesterday). **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 7,341 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol (855 since yesterday).**

For our nearby neighbors, Aransas County will be testing residents for COVID-19 on April 23-24 from 9AM to 5 PM at the Fulton Convention Center. Advanced registration is required. You may register by calling 512-883-2400. This testing is part of a deployment of mobile testing sites that is expected to administer an additional 3,500 tests per day across Texas.

As a reminder, Live Oak Park will re-open at 8AM tomorrow morning. All playground equipment and toy structures within the park will remain excluded from public use. All visitors in the park will be required to wear face covering and maintain a six-foot distance from individuals outside of their party. Also, gatherings in excess of 5 persons are prohibited.

The City is carefully evaluating and preparing a strategic plan to re-open our city, while continuing to abide by safe standards to ensure our residents remain healthy.
