COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 23, 2020

GREAT NEWS TO REPORT - There are still no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County also has no new cases—and are still reporting only 11 cases. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-1, Live Oak County-4, Kleberg County-7, Jim Hogg-1, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, and Bee County-5. Nueces County did report one more positive case today, bringing their total to 91, with 27 of their cases recovered.

Texas is now reporting 21,944 cases (increase of 875 since yesterday) with 561 fatalities (increase of 18 since yesterday) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 225,078 tests given across Texas (8,295 since yesterday). **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 8,025 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol (684 since yesterday).**

San Patricio County has announced mobile testing will be conducted on Friday, April 24, 2020 at the County Fairgrounds in Sinton. They will also conduct testing on Saturday, April 25, 2020 at Gonzalo Paiz Park in Mathis. This testing is by appointment only and advanced registration is required. You may register by calling 512-883-2400 or visit www.txcovidtest.org . This testing is part of a deployment of mobile testing sites that is expected to administer an additional 3,500 tests per day across Texas.

In accordance with my most recent Amendment to the Mayoral Declaration retail services that are not “essential services” may re-open effective **12:01 AM on Friday, April 24, 2020** provided they are able to provide their service through pick-up, delivery by mail, or delivery to the customer’s doorstep.

I encourage all of you to continue practicing social distancing, wash your hands, wear your masks, and keep the faith. We are all in this together—and we will get through this together!
