**COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 24, 2020**

There are still no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County also has no new cases—still reporting only 11 cases. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-1, Live Oak County-4, Kleberg County-8, Jim Hogg-1, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, and Bee County-5. Nueces County did report one more positive case today, bringing their total to 92. Both Nueces County and Kleberg County increased their positive cases by one today.

Texas is now reporting 22,806 cases (increase of 862 since yesterday) with 593 fatalities (increase of 32 since yesterday) as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 242,547 tests given across Texas (17,469 since yesterday). **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 9,156 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol (1131 since yesterday).**

Mobile testing was conducted today at the County Fairgrounds in Sinton. Mobile testing will also be conducted tomorrow (Saturday, April 25, 2020) at Gonzalo Paiz Park in Mathis. This testing is by appointment only and advanced registration is required. You may register by calling 512-883-2400 or visit [www.txcovidtest.org](http://www.txcovidtest.org). You MUST be pre-registered, or you will be asked to get out of line, and call to register for an appointment. The testing is free of charge. This testing is part of a deployment of mobile testing sites, led by the Texas Division of Emergency Management and the Texas Department of State Health Services, that is expected to administer an additional 3,500 tests per day across Texas.

The City of Ingleside has not yet had a positive case, and San Patricio County's numbers continue to be low. We appreciate all of you who helped us get out in front of this pandemic. Without your support, I am certain our numbers would be comparable to other surrounding counties, with many more confirmed cases. I encourage all of you to continue practicing social distancing, wash your hands, wear your masks, and keep the faith. We are all in this together—and we will get through this together!
