COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 29, 2020

There are still no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX as of 5 PM today. San Patricio County also has no new cases—still reporting only 11 cases, with 10 of those having recovered, leaving 1 active case in the County. San Patricio County has tested 127 persons thus far. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-2, Live Oak County-5, Kleberg County-8, Jim Hogg-2, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, and Bee County-5, and Nueces County-99.

Texas is now reporting 27,054 cases with 732 fatalities as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 314,790 tests given across. **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 12,507 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol.**

Today, I signed Mayoral Declaration of Disaster and Executive Order #7. Below are some key points of that Order:

- The City of Ingleside Public Library will reopen to the public on Friday, May 1, 2020 and shall follow guidelines, recommendations, or requirements as established by the Governor of the State of Texas.
- All City of Ingleside Parks shall be re-opened for day use only. Visitors are encouraged to wear face covering and maintain a six-foot distance from individuals outside of their party. Gathering of groups larger than 5 is prohibited.
- All City of Ingleside boat ramps will re-open at 8:00 AM on Thursday, April 30, 2020 and will be available for use between 6 AM and 6 PM. The boat ramp and parking area will be strictly for the use of **San Patricio County residents**. Boaters are encouraged to wear face covering and maintain a six-foot distance from individuals outside their party. Groups larger than 5 persons are prohibited. Non-resident guides are allowed only if carrying a group of residents from San Patricio County.
- Curfew is still in effect from 11 PM to 5 AM.
