**COVID-19 UPDATE – MAY 25, 2020**

Earlier today, San Patricio County reported one more active case bring their total to 29 cases. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-5, Duval County-5, Live Oak County-10, Kleberg County-16, Jim Hogg-4, Jim Wells -9, Brooks County-1, Refugio County-3, Bee County-9, and Nueces County-263.

Texas is now reporting 55,971 cases with 1,527 fatalities because of COVID-19. There has been a total of 906,074 tests given across Texas. **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 35,292 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol.**

This week the State of Texas will prepare for the re-opening of youth camps and youth sports. They can resume effective May 31, 2020. There are many protocols which much be followed while effectively making this a reality.
