COVID-19 UPDATE – MAY 4, 2020

Despite earlier reports from the media, there are still no confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Ingleside, TX. San Patricio County has increased to 12 cases. Other counties in the Coastal Bend are reporting the following confirmed cases: Aransas County-2, Duval County-2, Live Oak County-5, Kleberg County-9, Jim Hogg-2, Jim Wells -3, Brooks County-1, and Bee County-5, and Nueces County-113.

Texas is now reporting 32,332 cases with 884 fatalities as a result of COVID-19. There has been a total of 407,398 tests given across. **On a positive note—there have been an estimated 16,090 persons who have recovered from COVID-19 in Texas and have been removed from the COVID-19 protocol.**

The Mobile Test Collection Site in Ingleside today conducted 52 tests between 9 AM and 5 PM. I would like to give a special thanks to the Texas National Guard, Texas Department of State Health Services, San Patricio Office of Emergency Management and all others involved in bringing this much needed testing to our area. If you were unable to make it today, you can always register for Aransas Pass for either Tuesday or Wednesday, or Portland for Thursday through Sunday. You **MUST PRE-REGISTER** for this test 24 hours, or less, in advance. To register, you can visit www.txcovidtest.org or call 512-883-2400. You do NOT have to be a resident of the hosting City to register for testing. You will be screened during this registration to see if you have any of the following symptoms:

**Fever or Chills * Cough * Fatigue * Body Aches/Muscle or Joint Pain * Shortness of Breath
Sore Throat * Headaches * Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea * Nasal Congestion * Loss of Taste/Smell**

Today, Judge David Krebs signed the San Patricio County Order Continuing Declaration of Local State Disaster for an additional 30 days.

I am in discussion with the City Manager and Emergency Management Coordinator on updating our latest Declaration. We should have more information to share with you on Thursday.
