 - Yes. This is an RFP for Design/Build Services

- ❖ What is the estimate project budget:
 - Project estimate is between \$100k and \$250k

- ❖ What is the “Peak Inrush Demand” or “Peak KVA”:
 - Highest peak loads recorded are 32.720 kW, 34.000 kW, and 45.560 kW

- ❖ All Proposals are due on **Wednesday, June 2 at 1:00PM**
